




- (18) And Jesus came to them and spake unto them, saying, All authority hath been given unto me in heaven and on earth.

...but they have not all obeyed the Gospel" (Rom. 10:13, 16; cf. 1 Cor. 15:1-4).



"The like figure whereunto even baptism doth also now save us (not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the [appeal for] a good conscience toward God,) by the resurrection of Jesus Christ" (1 Pet. 3:21).

KJV "answer" of a good conscience defined by Thayer:

- 1) an enquiry, a question
- 2) a demand
- 3) earnestly seeking3a) craving, an intense desire

I do not have the power (or authority) to save myself,

but all power (or authority) has been given to the Lord;

therefore, I must appeal to the power (authority, name) of the Lord to be saved!

"And being made perfect, he became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him" (Hebrews 5:9).

Lord for salvation when I obey what the Author authorized us to do to be saved!

We call upon the name of the Lord to be saved when we are Scripturally baptized in the name of the Lord!
