Jesus loves you, but He wants you to understand that He is the righteous Lord of all, and you should obey Him (Matthew 4:4; 28:18-20; John 20:28; 1 Timothy 6:14-16).

Jesus loves you, but if you are ashamed of Him or His Words in this life, He will be ashamed of you on the Day of Judgment (Mark 8:38).

Jesus loves you, but if you reject the sacrifice He made, He will not forget it (1 Corinthians 15:1-4; 2 Thessalonians 1:7-9; 1 Peter 4:17).

Jesus loves you, and He wants you to be saved by doing what He said (Mark 16:16; Matthew 10:32; Acts 2:38; 22:16; Romans 6:3-5, 17-18; 1 Peter 3:20-21).

Jesus loves you, but if you love your life (or lifestyle) more than you love Him, you cannot be His disciple (Matthew 10:38-39; 16:24-26; 22:36-39; Galatians 2:20; Romans 6:1-13; 12:1-2).

Jesus loves you, but if you love your family more than you love Him, you cannot be His disciple (Matthew 10:34-37; Luke 14:25-26).

Jesus loves you, but if you love the things of this world more than you love Him, you cannot be His disciple (Matthew 6:19-21, 33; 16:26; Luke 18:17-30; James 4:4; 1 John 2:15-17).

Jesus loves you, but if you are unwilling to make great sacrifices for Him, you cannot be His disciple (Luke 14:33; 18:17-30; Acts 21:13; Romans 12:1-2; Revelation 2:10).

Jesus loves you, but if you have sin in your life, He warns you to change (Luke 13:3; 24:47; Acts 2:38; 17:30; 26:20).

Jesus loves you, but one day He will judge your life by His Words (John 12:48; Matthew 7:21-23; 2 Corinthians 5:10-11; Revelation 20:12-13).

Jesus loves you, but in Judgment He will not overlook sins of which you have not repented (John 5:27-29; Acts 17:30-31; 1 Corinthians 5:5; 6:9-11; Galatians 5:19-21; 6:1; Revelation 20:12-15; 21:8).

Jesus loves you, but if you are not faithful after becoming a Christian, He will not give you a crown of life (Revelation 2:10; 2 Peter 2:20-22; Heb. 10:23-31; James 5:19-20).

Jesus loves you, but He said you do not truly love Him if you do not obey Him (John 14:15; 1 John 2:3-5; 5:3; Luke 6:46).

Jesus loves you, but if you will not show your love by obeying Him, He will cast you into an everlasting lake of fire prepared for the devil and his angels (Matthew 7:21-23; 25:41; Romans 11:22; Hebrews 5:9; 10:23-31; 12:28-29; Revelation 20:15).
